The position will involve teaching three undergraduate courses each semester. Courses will include: Introduction to Digital Media; Copyright, Commerce, and Culture; Media, Technology and Society, and other courses in the area of digital media. The position will have no advisement or service obligations, but the successful candidate will be expected to be an active teacher who will engage in the intellectual life of the program and the department.
